- Click LINCOLN COLLEGE ALUMNI
- Enter the password **LincolnCA**

2 Order

- **Order to Switzerland and Lichtenstein:** Please email josephine.ruegsegger@lincoln.ox.ac.uk directly to place your order. She will take the order via email and LCBC will invoice you directly. Please note that the delivery might take until summer 2022.

3 Delivery

- Delivery of racing (technical) kit items produced by Mizuno Garments scheduled for dispatch w/c before February 2022 if the order has been placed before 22nd October 2021.
- Delivery of casual (social) kit items within 4 weeks of order date

4 Additional points to note


- Please note that after 14 days of the order date all orders are binding

Stitch Rowing


1 Sign up and registration

- Go to www.stitchrowing.com
- Click "Signup" (see below a)
- Register by choosing **Lincoln College Oxford** as your Club (see below b)
- Complete and save your MY ACCOUNT details (see below c)
- Hover over SHOP, click on **All Team Branded Kit** (see below d) and our club shop will load




b) Complete the form choosing **Lincoln College** (example shows Windsor) as your club and click register

2 Order

- **Order to the US:** Please email lisa@stitchrowing.com directly to place your order. She will take the order via email and invoice you. You will be liable for any taxes and duties payable on entry to the US.
- **Zephyrs:**
 - **White Club Zephyrs** Those of you who are supporters of Lincoln College Boat Club and/or who rowed for LCBC may want to purchase a white Club Zephyr

- **Navy blue WOMEN'S and MEN'S 1st VIII:** Those of you who rowed for the Lincoln College 1st VIII might also want to consider purchasing the traditional navy blue 1st VIII Zephyr
- **SIZING (Zephyrs):**
 - Men's (chest measurements): XXS = 30-32" XS= 33-35" S= 36-38" M = 37-39" L = 40-42" XL = 42-44" XXL = 46-48"
 - Women's (general sizing): XXS = 6 XS = 8 S = 10 M= 12 L= 14 XL = 16 XXL = 18
- **Imp Leggings:** typical sizing from XXS-XXL. TIP: go for your usual leggings size, but if between sizes, size up to avoid the print stretching to look lighter
- **Sportsbras:** general sizing XS = 8 S = 10 M= 12 L= 14 XL = 16 XXL = 18

3 Delivery

- Select standard delivery and input your address for delivery.
- **Delivery to addresses outside the UK:** Please take note that you will be liable for the additional costs due to international shipping as well as any taxes and duties payable on entry to your home country.
- Delivery scheduled for dispatch w/c November 22nd 2021

4 Additional points to note

- Ordering outside of a club order window is possible, but may incur additional lead times
- As all garments are made to order, we do not offer refunds/exchanges due to wrong sizes purchased. If you have any queries over size or how much give a garment has for example, please give Stitch Rowing a call on 01684 368423 or email lisa@stitchrowing.com. They are happy to help!
